

## **Behavioral Science Faculty Opening**

The University of Utah Department of Family and Preventive Medicine is seeking a full-time Behavioral Science faculty member. This position is at the Assistant Professor (Clinical) rank and involves 50% academic and 50% clinical responsibilities.

Clinical responsibilities include: Assessment and treatment of patients with a wide variety of psychological disorders referred through the Department's two family medicine residency clinics; consultation and emergency coverage for Family Medicine patients as needed.

Academic responsibilities: clinical, small group and didactic teaching in the behavioral science training program of Department's Family Medicine Residency; development of research and scholarly activities relevant to the program's mission; collaboration with the department's Physician Assistant, Public Health, Occupational Medicine, and Health Research programs. Clinical duties: providing behavioral medicine and psychotherapeutic services in the Department's two family medicine residency clinics.

Requirements: Doctoral degree in psychology; APA-approved internship in counseling or clinical psychology; licensure or license-eligibility at a psychologist in the state of Utah. Experience in primary care medical settings, medical teaching, and grant writing preferred.

In addition, the ideal candidate for this position is a well trained psychologist comfortable in a collaborative primary care environment, interested in teaching the next generation of physicians, experienced in clinical research and teaching, and willing to think "outside the box" of traditional mental health and disciplinary boundaries.
