RESIDENT PAYS

Take USMLE Step 3 Exam	\$690
COST TO RESIDENT (with/without controlled substance)	\$690

GME PAYS

(If application submitted to GME by July 31st)

Utah medical license application	\$200
Utah controlled substance license application	\$90
Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) report	\$420
COST TO GME PER RESIDENT (with controlled substance)	\$710
COST TO GME PER RESIDENT (without controlled substance)	\$620

Renewal Fees every other year

COST PER RESIDENT FOR MEDICAL LICENSE ONLY	\$183
COST PER RESIDENT FOR MEDICAL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE LICENSES	\$251
