**OSHA #2045: Machinery and
Machine Guarding Standards
July 7-10, 2009**

This OSHA course familiarizes the student with various types of common machinery and the related safety standards. Guidance is provided with respect to the hazards associated with various types of machinery. The course presents an approach to machine inspection that enables participants to recognize hazards such as those created by points of operation, ingoing nip points, rotating parts, and flying chips and sparks, and provides some options to achieve abatement. Course highlights include demonstrations of various machines and guarding methods. Please make note that on Day Four of class there will be an inspection field trip to a local company. Students are required to wear appropriate clothing: sturdy, close-toed, non-slip shoes and long pants (preferably jeans). Students are NOT to wear: loose clothing, ties or scarves, ponytails, excess jewelry or hooded sweatshirts.

Students completing this course should be able to:

- * Recognize and identify various machines
- * Identify basic machinery terms
- * Recognize common machinery hazards
- * Recommend selected abatement methods
- * Use the appropriate OSHA standard

**Permit-Required Confined
Space Entry (OSHA #2264)
July 8-10, 2009**

This course will increase your knowledge of hazards associated with permit-required confined space entry. Topics include the OSHA-required confined space entry standard, hazards associated with entry procedures, personal protective equipment, ventilation and purging requirements, calculations and techniques, and appropriate atmosphere testing equipment and related limitations. Course features hands-on training with explosion meters, oxygen meters, and other test equipment.

NOTE: Students are required to bring a personal calculator to this course.
