WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The professional responsibilities of many practicing occupational safety and health professionals (including Occupational Hygienists, Safety Professionals, Engineers, Occupational Health Nurses, Occupational Physicians) are not always comprehensive across all technical and program areas. This course attempts to provide as thorough and intensive a review of the field of Occupational Hygiene as can be offered in five days. The course is an excellent way to get a broad refresher of the field as-a-whole, or to specifically review materials in preparation for the ABIH exam. Although, taking the course certainly does not guarantee passage of any standardized exam.

TOPICS

The course uses daily quizzes, lectures, and problem solving sessions. Materials are designed to review critical content areas and cover the eight content domains identified by ABIH's Job Analysis working group.

- Occupational Disease, Illness, Injury and Surveillance
- Health Hazards
- Work Environments
- Program Management Principles
- Evaluation Practices
- Hazard Controls
- Community Stressors

Beginning in 2010, ABIH requires exam applicants to complete at least two hours of coursework in ethics. This course provides a two hour section on ethics.


