# **The New Student Organization Registration Process**

#### Introduction

Students can start their own student organization at the University of Utah by completing the New Student Organization Registration Process!

Before you get started you will need:

- Three (3) currently registered, matriculated students who want to be in the new student organization.
- A constitution that meets the ORG constitution guidelines as outlined in the Sample Constitution.

Before you begin this process, we recommend that you double-check that there are no existing student organizations similar to the organization you want to start. You can check out our existing organizations on <a href="Campus Connect">Campus Connect</a>.

The New Student Organization Application will open on Monday, July 31 and close on Sunday, March 4 at 11:59 pm.

### **New Student Organization Registration Form**
